



Product information 2026

Our entire assortment of **perennials and grasses** originate from **vegetative propagation** (cuttings, root cuttings, division). **All stockplants that we use are cultivated in our own nursery in Uchte, Northern-Germany.**

Substrate and plant protection: We use a slightly fertilised peat/wood fiber/perlite substrate for the cultivation of our plants. Preventively we strengthen the youngplants with algae extract. If necessary, we fertilize with stored fertilizer so well-nourished plants are delivered. We do not use growth hormones or inhibitors. Fungicides and insecticides are used if necessary.

According to their growth habit, our young plants are cultivated in different trays.

4x4cm (54) = 4cm cells (Teku one-way, 54 plants/tray), e.g. Delphinium, Pennisetum

3x3cm (80) = 3cm cells (Teku one-way, 80 plants/tray), e.g. Cotula, Aster, Armeria

2.5cm (104) = 2.5cm cells (Teku one-way, 100 plants/tray), e.g. Lavandula, Coreopsis vert.

5cm (54) = 8-angular cells with a diameter of 5 cm (one-way, 54 plants/tray), e.g. Miscanthus

The standard size for each plant is specified in the list of products. The cell size may differ if required by the production.

Some species and varieties we cultivate in **Growcoons** – marked with "GC" in the quality designation (e.g. **4x4 GC (54)** or **3x3 GC (80)**). Growcoon is a net-like, biodegradable culture container made from biopolymers to stabilize the rootballs and to make it easier to remove the young plants from the trays. The Growcoon stays on the rootball and is potted along with it. The Growcoon is approved for organic farming (FIBL listing; <https://fibl.org>)

Plants are delivered tray by tray only.

A delivery period is specified for every plant in the catalogue. You will receive an order confirmation with an approximate delivery date. Shortly before the delivery, exact dates will be agreed upon via e-mail. You may specify your preferred delivery date – we will take it into consideration.

We prepare **plant divisions** so that they are ready for planting (this means that the shoots and roots are trimmed). The divisions normally have 1-2 shoots and they are ideal for 9cm pots. Prices are calculated on this basis. Larger divisions (e.g. grasses for containers in the spring) may also be delivered; the prices must be stipulated. **The minimum purchase is 100 plants per variety.** Delivery dates upon arrangement.

An **(S)** next to the variety name stands for **plant variety protection**; an **(R)** stands for trademark protection. The (S) protected plants may only be propagated with permission by the holder of the plant variety protection rights. The symbols (S) and (R) are required for every trade level. Names in CAPITAL LETTERS are trade names. **All prices of the varieties marked with (S) or (R) include the license fees.**

CONTINIs® - 6cm or 7cm goods for delivery in springtime are for 1-3 litre containers.

We produce them only when ordered in advance. For spring 2027, the latest order must be placed in June 2026.
